Sioux City -- Woodbury County Conservation Board will host a Camping Kickoff Weekend May 6-8. Campgrounds participating in the Kickoff Weekend include Southwood Conservation Area near Smithland, Little Sioux Park near Correctionville, and Snyder Bend Park and Brown's Lake-Bigelow Park near Salix.
