

RULES - REGULATIONS

- Smoking is prohibited inside the cabins.
- Pets/animals are prohibited in or near the cabins.
- Keg beer is prohibited.
- Cabin furniture must remain inside cabins.
- Cooking inside cabins is strictly prohibited except for microwave (provided) and coffee maker (not provided). All cooking should be done outdoors over campfires and grills (provided) or stoves (not provided).
- Cleaning fish/game is prohibited in or near cabins.
- Park hours must be observed.
6:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.—May 1st to October 31st
- Quiet hours are 10:30 p.m.—6:00 a.m.
Non-registered guests must leave by 10:30 p.m.
- Tents and campers are not allowed in cabin area.
Please use campground.
- No one under the age of 21 is allowed to reserve a cabin or occupy a cabin unless accompanied by parent or legal guardian of at least 21 years of age.
- All Rules & Regulations of the Woodbury County Conservation Board are in effect.
- Failure to abide by the Cabin Policy or Cleanup Guidelines may result in a charge of up to \$50.
- Violation of park rules and regulations may result in fines, use privileges being rescinded, and forfeiture of reservation fees.
- Woodbury County Conservation board reserves the right of management to enter the cabins in an emergency, to inspect, and/or to replenish supplies.

LITTLE SIOUX PARK

- Located 2 miles southwest of Correctionville, Iowa, on Hwy 31, this 547-acre area provides a wide variety of recreational opportunities for the public.
- A 95-unit campground has water, electricity, modern restrooms and shower facilities.
- The 10-acre lake has angling opportunities for large-mouth bass, bluegill and channel catfish. Only electric trolling motors, oars and paddles are allowed on all county-owned lakes.
- There is a designated beach area. No lifeguards.
- Modern playground equipment is located near the campground.
- Hiking trails offer opportunities to explore the marsh, native trees, shrub plantings, native prairies and food plots.

SPECIFICATIONS

- Woodbury County Conservation Board offers four (4) one-room camping cabins from May 1 to October 31.
- Built in 2001, the cabins are designed to offer a camping experience with a few comforts of home to those who do not own a camper, motor home or tent.
- Cabins are one room (16' x 18') with a 10' covered deck.
- Cabins are handicap accessible.
- Maximum number of occupants per cabin is 6.

VEHICLES – PARKING

- Parking is available immediately adjacent to each cabin for a maximum of two (2) standard vehicles.
- No tents, R.V.'s, fifth wheel campers, pickup campers, popups, etc. will be allowed at the cabin site or in the cabin parking lot.

CHECK IN – CHECK OUT

- Renters may check in after **4:00 p.m.** on the first day of the cabin reservation and are required to check out by **1:00 p.m.** on the last day of the reservation.
- Cabin keys may be retrieved from the key safe lockbox on the cabin.
- Returned keys are to be locked inside the cabin. Lost or stolen keys will result in a \$50 replacement charge.
- Cabins and surrounding grounds should be cleaned and left in good condition.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Renters are responsible for all guests and any damages, loss, or theft occurring during stay.
- Renters are responsible for cleaning cabin as required.

RESERVATION PROCEDURES

- Cabins are available by reservation only and may be reserved up to 12 months in advance.
- All reservations are taken at Dorothy Pecaut Nature Center by phone (712-258-0838) or in person.
- Cabin fees for the entire stay must be paid when reservations are made. Payment options include most major credit cards or cash. (No checks)
- Renter must be at least 21 years of age.
- Reservations are taken on a first-come/first-pay, first-served basis.
- Minimum two-night stay on weekends. (Fri./Sat.)
- Minimum three-night stay on holiday weekends.
- Maximum stay of 14 days within a 30-day period.

ONLINE CABIN RESERVATIONS COMING SOON!

All Woodbury County Conservation cabin & shelter reservations will be taken at **MyCountyParks.com** beginning January 1, 2017.

CANCELLATIONS

- A minimum fee of \$30 will be charged for any cancellation or change of reservation. If cancellation or change of reservation is made 30 or fewer days before arrival, one night's rental fee will be forfeited.
- If the Conservation Board must cancel reservation due to circumstances beyond its control, the rental fee will be refunded in full.
