Sioux City, IA—Youth in Grades Kindergarten through 12th grade that reside in one of the seven counties within the Loess Hills Region of Iowa are eligible to participate in a Loess Hills & Heritage Poster Contest. These counties include Plymouth, Woodbury, Monona, Harrison, Pottawattamie, Mills and Fremont Counties in Iowa.

Loess Hills & Heritage Week is scheduled for the week of September 23 through October 1, 2017, with activities scheduled throughout the 7-county Loess Hills region. One significant activity planned is an educational poster contest for youth. Cash prizes will be awarded to the First Place in each age division in each county, and also for an overall winner in each age division.

The theme is “Living in the Loess,” and there are three age divisions; K-3, 4-6, and 7-12. We encourage participating youth to interpret the theme creatively: “Living” can mean flora and fauna, but also can include human culture, history, and activities, etc.
